

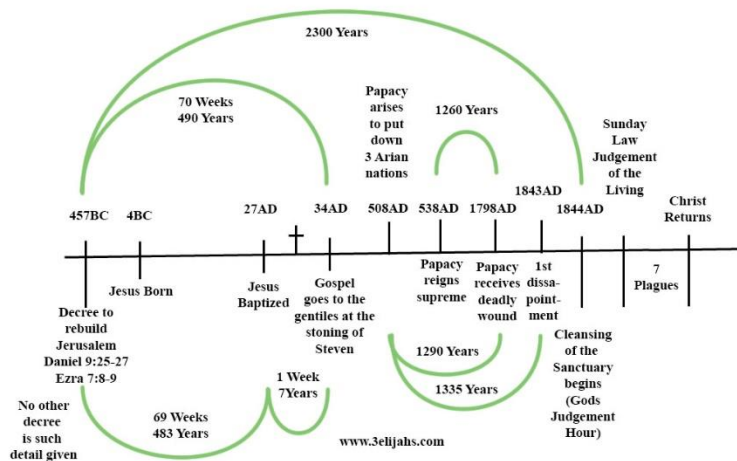

Daniel 8:14

14 And he said to me, "For two thousand three hundred days; then the sanctuary shall be cleansed."



John 16:8-11 - The 3rd work of the Holy Spirit is to judge

8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of **sin**, and of **righteousness**, and of **judgment**: 9 Of **sin**, because they **believe not** on me; 10 Of **righteousness**, because I go to my Father, and ye **see me** no more; 11 Of **judgment**, because the **prince of this world is judged**.

- Sin - Unbelief
- The Holy Spirit gives righteousness & healing from sin
- Judgement - Satan's kingdom is judged

John 14:15-18

15 "If you love Me, keep My commandments. 16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— 17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but **you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you**. 18 **I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you**.

John 16:14

He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you.

Acts 17:31

For He has set a day when He will judge the world with justice by the Man He has appointed. He has given proof of this to everyone by raising Him from the dead."

The 3rd Commandment - The only one associated with judgement

Deuteronomy 5:11

11 'You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him **guiltless** who takes His name in vain.

Exodus 20:7

7 "You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him **guiltless** who takes His name in vain.

Taking His name in vain is: having a form of Godliness but denying His power, to heal us from sin & write His law on our hearts.

2Timothy 3:1-5

1 But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: 2 For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, 3 unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, 4 traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, 5 **having a form of godliness but denying its power.**

Jeremiah 51:9 - **Judgement reaches to heaven when she makes void Gods Law We would have healed Babylon**, But she is not healed. Forsake her, and let us go everyone to his own country; **For her judgment reaches to heaven and is lifted up to the skies.**

Psalm 119:126

It is time for thee, LORD, to work: **for they have made void thy law.**

Revelation 13:7-8,12,14-17 - Worship by keeping laws. Speaking with punishment are laws

7 It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them. **And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation.** 8 All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have **not** been written in the **Book of Life** of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. ...12 And he exercises **all the authority of the first beast in his presence**, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. ...14 And **he deceives** those who dwell on the earth by those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the

beast, **telling** those who dwell on the earth to make an image **to** the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived. He was granted **power** to **give breath** to the image **of** the beast, that the image of the beast should both **speak** and cause as many as would **not worship** the image of the beast **to be killed**. 16 **He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark** on their right hand or on their foreheads, 17 **and that no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark** or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

(*Read Isaiah 10-11 The Assyrian is a type of the Papacy. The fall of Babylon, Isaiah 14, Isaiah 21:9, Revelation 14:8, Revelation 18:2)

The Hour of the Power of darkness - Denotes a short but powerful trial

Matthew 26:40

Then He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, "What! **Could you not watch with Me one hour?**

Matthew 26:45

Then He came to His disciples and said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? Behold, **the hour is at hand, and the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of sinners.**

Mark 14:35

He went a little farther, and fell on the ground, and prayed that if it were possible, **the hour might pass from Him.**

Mark 14:37

Then He came and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, "**Simon, are you sleeping? Could you not watch one hour?**

Mark 14:41

Then He came the third time and said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? It is enough! **The hour has come;** behold, the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of sinners.

*Luke 22:53

When I was with you daily in the temple, you did not try to seize Me. But **this is your hour, and the power of darkness.**"

*Revelation 3:10

Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the **hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world**, to test those who dwell on the earth.

*Revelation 17:12

"The ten horns which you saw are ten kings who have received no kingdom as yet, but they receive authority for **one hour** as kings with the beast.

John 16:32

Indeed **the hour** is coming, yes, has now come, that you will be scattered, each to his own, and will leave Me alone. And yet I am not alone, because the Father is with Me.

John 17:1

Jesus Prays for Himself

Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, **the hour has come**. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You,

1 Corinthians 4:10-12

10 We are fools for Christ's sake, but you are wise in Christ! We are weak, but you are strong! You are distinguished, but we are dishonored! 11 **To the present hour** we both hunger and thirst, and we are poorly clothed, and beaten, and homeless. 12 And we labor, working with our own hands. 1 John 2:18

Deceptions of the Last Hour

Little children, it is **the last hour**; and as you have heard that the Antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have come, by which we know that it is **the last hour**.

The Times of Scripture - 1260 days = 42 months = a time, and times, and half a time = 3 1/2 years

Revelation 11:2

But exclude the courtyard outside the temple. Do not measure it, because it has been given over to the nations, and they will trample the holy city for **42 months**.

Revelation 11:3

And I will empower my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for **1,260 days**, clothed in sackcloth."

Revelation 12:14

But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle to fly from the presence of the serpent to her place in the wilderness, where she was nourished for **a time, and times, and half a time**.

Revelation 13:5

The beast was given a mouth to speak arrogant and blasphemous words, and authority to act for **42 months**.

Daniel 7:25

He will speak out against the Most High and oppress the saints of the Most High, intending to change the appointed times and laws; and the saints will be given into his hand for **a time, and times, and half a time**.

Daniel 12:7

And the man dressed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, raised his right hand and his left hand toward heaven, and I heard him swear by Him who lives forever, saying, "It will be for **a time, and times, and half a time**. Daniel 12:11

11 "And from the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, there shall be **one thousand two hundred and ninety days**. 12 Blessed is he who waits, and comes to the **one thousand three hundred and thirty-five days**.
